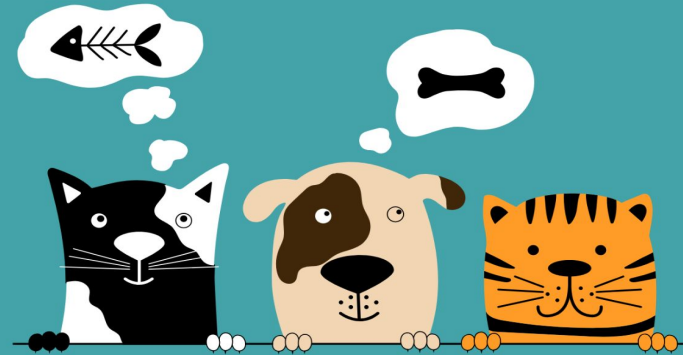
## Check out our new green house
